In a challenging market, Schneider Electric required a new site to accommodate for their predicted future growth, with the incorporation of an automation and technology strategy.

Client Challenges

With an impending lease expiry, Schneider had to review their distribution center strategy for their key Hub Asia site.

The existing site had limited capacity and could not accommodate predicted future growth. All other Schneider sites across their network worldwide had already implemented technology and automation strategies, except their Hub Asia site.

Approach

TMX were engaged to review the automation options and payback period at a high level, as well as develop a racking and MHE solution, with the building fit-out scoped and tendered by TMX.

On completion of these phases, TMX continued to manage both the construction and automation components of the project.

Solution

An appropriate site was procured in a limited market, a **short time frame**, and with a **competitive rental rate** on a long-term lease.

The **fit-out was completed on time**, despite supply and labor shortages through the global pandemic, going live in line with the lease expiry on existing sites.
